



## **Sustainability Policy Declaration**

Electric Picnic is committed to reducing its direct and indirect carbon footprint and has taken steps internally to address our impacts. Externally we are keen to reduce the impact of our suppliers and as such all food and market traders are asked to comply with the following;

- ABSOLUTELY NO PLASTIC OR POLYSTYRENE packaging or cutlery to be present onsite. Any brought in with deliveries must be taken away by trader.
- All food stalls must serve food and hot drinks in biodegradable and compostable receptacles – including all bowls, containers, cups, coffee cup lids and cutlery.
- Disposable cups for cold drinks must be paper coated in polyethylene, unless previously agreed with the Sustainability Coordinator. Cups will only be given out as a sale of a product and not given away.
- Avoid using single serve sachets for spreads, condiments, sugar, salt, sauces.
- Do not supply plastic straws, only compostable paper straws.

Where possible foods, especially meats and fish, should be from certified sustainable farms, locally sourced and seasonal. Eggs should be free range.

- All stalls - please don't bring plastic bags to site to put sold items in. Encourage customers to use reusable bags by having them available for sale.

There will be sets of three different bins back of house for you to correctly dispose of your waste. Please do not block service access to the bins back of house and segregate your waste as follows:

- Mixed recycling (plastic, glass, metals, paper) into 240L or 1100L recycling bins
- Flattened cardboard for collection
- Food waste into the food waste bin – completely separated from the rest.
- Landfill waste into general waste bins (this should be minimal)
- Waste vegetable oil should be stored in drums and removed after the show. This is your responsibility. Under no circumstances should waste oil be poured onto the ground.

It is the responsibility of the trader to ensure that no rubbish remains when leaving the site. Your area should be 'clear of commercial waste'. Should rubbish be found on the pitch after the Trader has departed a harsh financial penalty will apply per tonne of waste left behind.

Compliance with the above will be monitored throughout the festival. Traders failing to meet these environmental requirements will be issued with a warning note. If the problem is not rectified within an agreed timeframe, their stalls will be closed down and they may be liable to a financial penalty.
