



## CAMPERVAN DO'S AND DON'TS

### DO'S

- DO** keep a clear separation distance of 3 meters between all campervans at all times. Any vehicles parking within the 3m distance will be asked to move or be removed.
- DO** make sure your pass is displayed correctly.
  - The mirror hanger needs to be clearly displayed in the windscreen of your campervan.
- DO** ensure that each person within the vehicle has a valid weekend ticket.
- DO** ensure that gas cylinders are fitted within the campervan. Cylinders should only be stored in the unit's gas locker; and must be 7kg or less.
- DO** ensure all litter is put into bins or recycling bins.
- DO** use the toilets provided in the campsite and not pollute streams or hedges.
- DO** read the T&C's of Entry for information on the prohibited items. Vehicles may be searched upon entry to the event and prohibited items will be confiscated.



### DON'TS

- DON'T** bring a makeshift campervan, they are not permitted. For more information on our definition of a campervan please see our Campervan & Caravan T&C's.
- DON'T** park your vehicle in the fire lanes at any time.
- DON'T** move your vehicle once it is parked.
- DON'T** bring additional vehicles into the campervan site. Additional vehicles must be parked in the general car parks.
- DON'T** bring a generator, the only exception is a diesel generator correctly fitted within the campervan.
- DON'T** erect tents or awnings in the campervan fields.
- DON'T** dispose of any wastewater (grey waste) by pouring it onto the ground, into a sump, or into a stream. Instead, use the provided containers for proper disposal.
- DON'T** use any large garden type furniture such as chimineas; fire pits; large wood burning stoves or any other item that is deemed to pose a risk to the safety of you or other campers at any time. We reserve the right to confiscate these items and/or refuse entry to the campervan/caravan area.
- DON'T** conduct any kind of trading from campervans as it's not permitted.
